around the countryside of South Oxfordshire

The PAGE Campaign - Parishes Against Gravel Extraction - is an alliance of 8 Parish Councils in South Oxfordshire working together to oppose plans for large-scale gravel extraction in our beautiful countryside.

The PAGE Country Day will be a thoroughly enjoyable day for you, your horse and your friends. The course routes are up to 10 miles over grass, arable farmland and tracks. The majority of the course is private farmland including the River Thames meadow, and will take you across the beautiful countryside currently under threat from gravel extraction. All proceeds from the Country Day will go to the PAGE Campaign.

Children on lead reins are welcome - a shorter course will be clearly marked for those leading on foot.

The route covers ground in the Chiselhampton, Stadhampton, Drayton St Leonard & Toot Baldon area, starting out at Camoys Farm, Chiselhampton, OX44 7UZ.

Extensive field parking and refreshments will be available through out the day. Rosettes will be given to all entrants at the end of their ride. Field parking opens at 8am, with first rides at 9am.

## Terms and Conditions

### General

Please note that the majority of the course is over private land and access is only permitted on Sunday 26th September.

It is a condition of entry that a non-refundable entry fee is paid prior to the event.

- Please make cheques payable to: **Parishes Against Gravel Extraction**
- Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn
- Body protectors and medical armbands are compulsory for Pony Club members and recommended for other participants
- Horses and ponies must be over 4 years old
- Careful and considerate passing is allowed
- Any dogs must be kept on leads at all times

### Disclaimer

Horse riding is an inherently dangerous activity and all reasonable care and precautions must be taken by each rider to ensure that all riders, spectators, horses and property are not injured or damaged.

The PAGE organisers confirm that they have inspected the course and have exercised reasonable care in satisfying themselves that the route is safe and secure prior to making the route available but except in respect of death or personal injury caused by PAGE's negligence no responsibility is accepted by PAGE for any damage to persons, horses or property howsoever caused which should arise from:

- a) Defects in the route not notified to PAGE organisers by the rider
- b) Defects in the route which manifest themselves after the route is made available

During the event it is possible that the may become less safe and secure. All riders shall be under a continuing duty to notify to the PAGE organisers of any damage which they cause to, or notice in, the route or the course during the event and to notify any defects to the PAGE organisers as it not possible for PAGE to inspect each section of the route after every rider has completed the course or any part of it.

PAGE shall be under no liability in respect of any damage caused to any person, horse or property howsoever caused including any defect in the route arising from fair wear and tear, wilful damage, negligence of any rider or others, or abnormal weather conditions, or failure to follow the PAGE organiser's instructions whether verbal or written.
